Character and Personality Development

These activities will mold students to

- 1. be well-rounded, possess teamwork skills and responsibilities, and adjust to living with other students in dormitories and the society through life-skills learning.
- 2. practice being an effective leader and a supportive team player, as well as be self-disciplined and conduct good religious practices according to their respective beliefs.
- 3. be proud of their home country and possess civic consciousness so that they will feel responsible and aim to do their best for the society.
- 4. acquire the motivation to read, write, research, study, and learn, as well as have the sense of appreciation for arts, music, and culture of every nationality and ethnicity.
- 5. maintain good physical, mental, and emotional health.
