

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES AT KAMNOETVIDYA SCIENCE ACADEMY

With that in mind, the Power of Learning Foundation was established as a licensed authority to institute a science high school dedicated to this mission. Kamnoetvidya Science Academy (KVIS) accepted its first batch of 72 students in May 2015. Today, the academy's enrolment is at a total of 216 students, offering a specialized curriculum to students from Grade 10 – 12.

The principal aim of KVIS is to nurture students who are gifted in mathematics and science to reach their full potential, ultimately, to contribute to the country's competitiveness as researchers, inventors and innovators. In line with the 21st century needs, these talented students undergo an education in English at the academy. The aim is to prepare and equip them with the ability to access global knowledge, to communicate with confidence, and to actively engage and collaborate with like-minded youth, both at local and international levels.

The academy is situated in a research and educational park, in Wangchan Valley, Rayong. The province is located in the eastern part of Thailand, approximately 150 kilometers from the capital, Bangkok. Situated amid lush and hilly green surroundings of tropical fruit trees, oil palms, and rubber plantations, the eco-peaceful atmosphere provides a highly-conducive learning environment and quality lifestyle to both students and teachers.

This upcoming semester, as part of its continuous expansion, the academy is seeking qualified staff with English proficiency equivalent to that of native speakers for the following positions:

General Qualifications

Applicants for all positions should possess or meet the following requirements:

1. Be able to work full-time and reside at the school's residence on the campus.
2. Be committed to the duties of a teacher and have the personality and characteristics of a good teacher. Applicants should believe in education for individuals who are gifted in science and mathematics, and should have good knowledge/understanding of and faith in KVIS's ideology and goals for the school and for student development.
3. Have outstanding academic records. Applicants who can demonstrate evidence of good and successful teaching would be favorably.

Education, Qualifications and Requirements

1. Native speakers, or non-native speakers of Thai or Foreigner nationals who can use English as a second language.
Non-native speaking applicants must have valid results from an English language proficiency test, such as TOEFL or IELTS.
2. Bachelor's degree in English, English literature, linguistics, education with a focus on teaching English, and/or a master's degree in English, English literature, linguistics, teaching English as a second language (TESL), teaching English as a foreign language (TEFL), or English as an international language (EIL).
3. Experience teaching AP or IGCSE English (L2 or L1), or experience preparing students for the SAT, TOEFL, or IELTS tests, is advantageous.

Required and Supporting Documents

1. A letter of intention, including your specific skills and abilities relevant to the specific tasks listed and your expected salary and benefits
2. Names, email addresses, and contact numbers (preferably mobile phone numbers) of two referees. It is the responsibility of an applicant to inform the referees that they may be contacted by KVIS. We may request letters of reference at a later date.
3. A copy of national identification card/passport.
4. A copy of transcripts of all degrees/programs of study
5. Certified statement(s) of work experience from employer(s), if applicable
6. A copy of a curriculum vitae (CV) in English

Interview

1. Successful applicants will be informed as to the time and date of an interview in February 28, 2018. Applicants living overseas will be interviewed online.

Terms & Conditions, Salary and Benefits

1. Employment will be offered on a one-year contractual basis. An employee will undergo a performance assessment at least once a year.
2. Salary and benefits are designed on the basis that the offer must be convincing to candidates that they can work at KVIS as dignified individuals. The salary and benefits are negotiable.
3. A roundtrip economy class air ticket from the city of your residence to Thailand will be provided.
4. Medical insurance will be provided throughout the employment contract.
5. Apartments within the compound of the academy are available for teachers and their families.
6. Work days, holidays, leaves of absence, and other benefits are as set in the rules and regulations of the academy.

Duties and responsibilities are as the followings:

1. Teach at least 12 teaching hours per week.
2. Be an advisor to student research projects.
3. Mentor new teachers who need teaching experiences. Prior experiences in mentoring teachers is advantageous.
