

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES AT KAMNOETVIDYA SCIENCE ACADEMY

With that in mind, the Power of Learning Foundation was established as a licensed authority to institute a science high school dedicated to this mission. Kamnoetvidya Science Academy (KVIS) accepted its first batch of 72 students in May 2015. Today, the academy's enrolment is at a total of 216 students, offering a specialized curriculum to students from Grade 10 – 12.

The academy is situated in a research and educational park, in Wang Chan Valley, Rayong. The province is located in the eastern part of Thailand, approximately 150 kilometers from the capital, Bangkok. Situated amid lush and hilly green surroundings of tropical fruit trees, oil palms, and rubber plantations, the eco-peaceful atmosphere provides a highly-conducive learning environment and quality lifestyle to both students and teachers.

General Qualifications

Applicants for all positions should possess or meet the following requirements:

1. Be able to work full-time and reside at the school's residence on campus.
2. Be committed to the duties of a teacher and possess the personality and characteristics of a good teacher.
3. Applicants should be committed to promoting quality education for individuals who are gifted in science and mathematics, and should possess good knowledge, understanding and faith in KVIS's ideology, and goals of the school and students' development.
4. Have outstanding academic records. Applicants who can demonstrate evidence of good and successful teaching or have five or more years of teaching experience would be favorably considered.

Education, Qualifications and Requirements

1. Postgraduate Diploma or MSc (thesis program) or Ph.D. in Chemistry or Chemistry Education or equivalent.
2. Be able to use English fluently in teaching.
3. Be able to teach Chemistry to high-ability students in Mathematics and Science at the Advanced Placement level of the US curriculum or at the A-Level for the UK curriculum.
4. An additional ability on teaching Earth Science at high school level or having experiences in advising students to do science projects would be advantageous.

1. A letter of intention, including your specific skills and abilities relevant to the specific tasks listed and your expected salary and benefits.
2. Names, email addresses, and contact numbers (preferably mobile phone numbers) of at least two referees. It is the responsibility of an applicant to inform the referees that they may be contacted by KVIS. We may request letters of reference at a later date.
3. A copy of national identification card/passport.
4. A copy of transcripts of all degrees/programs of study.
5. Certified statement(s) of work experience from employer(s), if applicable.
6. A curriculum vitae (CV) in English.

Interview

1. Shortlisted applicants will be informed of the time and date for an interview by September 2018.
2. Applicants living overseas will be interviewed online.

Terms & Conditions, Salary and Benefits

1. The employment will be offered on a one-year contractual basis. An employee will undergo a performance assessment at least once a year.
2. The salary and benefits are designed on the basis that the offer must be sufficiently attractive and is convincing to the candidates that they can work at KVIS as a dignified individual. The salary and benefits are negotiable.
3. A roundtrip economy class air ticket from the city of your residence to Thailand will be provided.
4. A medical insurance covering medical expenses throughout the employment contract will be provided.
5. An apartment within the residence hall of the academy will be available to the successful candidates.
6. Work days, holidays, leave of absence and other benefits will be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the academy.
